LOCATION	Zephyr Cove is located on Lake Tahoe's South shore, 4 miles Northeast of Stateline on Hwy 50. The rental office for all accommodations is located across the street from the Lodge, adjacent to the RV Park between May and October. In other months it is located in the main lodge.

OVERVIEW	Located on the South Shore of Lake Tahoe just four miles from Stateline, Nevada, Zephyr Cove Resort & Marina has been a historic recreational destination for more than a century, and today offers everything from camping and lakeside cabins to snowmobiling, boating, parasailing, kayaking and cruises to scenic Emerald Bay. The Zephyr Cove Marina, which offers a host of boat and watercraft rentals, also serves as the departure point for the M.S. Dixie II, voted "Best of Tahoe" for the past 12 years. The M.S. Dixie II offers daily cruises ranging from a weekly breakfast buffet brunch in the summer to the sightseeing and dinner/dance cruise which runs year-round. Zephyr Cove Snowmobile Center is one of the largest in the U.S and it is the only snowmobile operation that tours to the Tahoe Ridgeline affording spectacular lake views.
LODGING	The Cabins at Zephyr Cove – 28 historic cabins, which range in size from studios to two-story units that sleep up to 10 people, sit on the shoreline of Lake Tahoe. All units feature: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• TV with HBO, WiFi, telephone, and coffee makers• Fully equipped kitchens in most units• Pets allowed for an additional nightly charge• Open year-round• Seasonal rates vary from \$139 - \$609 per night

Lodge – Four guest rooms that sleep from four to six people have convenient access to the lodge's many amenities. All units feature:

- Private baths
- WiFi, coffee maker, mini-refrigerator and microwave
- Open year-round
- Seasonal rates vary from \$99 - \$249 per night

Luxury Suite – The new luxury suite offers a more spacious and luxurious version of our classic Tahoe cabins. Features include:

- Marble bathroom with jacuzzi, steam and rain showers
- Two flat screen TVs, WiFi
- Mini refrigerator, microwave, wine cooler and bar
- Spacious living area
- King size bed
- Seasonal rates vary from \$239 - \$289

RV PARK

Zephyr Cove's award-winning RV Park offers 93 newly redesigned RV sites, 47 "walk-in" sites and 10 "drive-in" sites. Campground amenities include:

- Accommodations for RVs up to 40' long
- Cable TV/Water/sewer/electrical hook-up/WiFi
- Picnic tables, fire rings, "bear-proof" food lockers, and barbeques
- Laundry and shower/toilet facilities
- Site snow removal during winter months
- RV sites are open year-round; campsites are closed in the winter
- Seasonal rates vary from \$15 - \$65 per night

DINING

Zephyr Cove Restaurant – A casual restaurant located in the main lodge with stunning lake views and a fireplace. The menu includes a selection of American favorites for breakfast, lunch and dinner. Indoor and outdoor seating is available.

Coffee Bar – Espresso drinks and hot and cold coffee favorites, plus a selection of other beverages and snacks, are available at the Coffee Bar, which is located next to the Zephyr Cove Restaurant in the main lodge.

Sunset Bar & Grille – Steps from the beach, Sunset Bar & Grille is open from late spring to early fall and serves casual fare such as burgers and fish tacos. Indoor and outdoor seating is available.

MARINA & WATER SPORTS

Cruises – Operating year-round, the M.S. Dixie II offers daily sightseeing cruises to Emerald Bay that depart from the Zephyr Cove Marina. From

spring through fall, a Sunday Brunch Cruise is added to the schedule. In the summer, the Emerald Bay Sightseeing Dinner Cruise runs daily. Rates range from \$41 to \$71 for adults, and \$20 to \$41 for children.

Boat Rentals – Visitors to the Zephyr Cove Marina can rent power boats, WaveRunners with or without GPS units, pedal boats, kayaks, canoes, or even go parasailing. The Marina is open year-round, weather permitting.

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Horseback Riding – Zephyr Cove Resort Stables offer daily guided rides on trails that overlook Lake Tahoe and the Sierra Nevada mountains. *For rates and schedules, call 775-588-5664.*

Sport Fishing – Tahoe Sport Fishing provides year-round charters for half or full day fishing trips. *For rates and schedules, call 775-586-9338.*

Beach Volleyball – Zephyr Cove Resort offers 10 sand volleyball courts right on the shores of Lake Tahoe and adjacent to the Sunset Bar & Grille.

Shoreline Events – Zephyr Cove's special events and wedding coordination group offers sites that can accommodate up to 2,000 people. Sites are ideal for corporate and social events, including weddings, receptions, teambuilding and barbecues. The outdoor pavilion offers covered seating for up to 150 people.
